<p>Please note that our driver will collect payments for the trips at one of the last stops wherever it is convenient. We ask that you please provide exact change for your seat and we do not accept \$50 or \$100 bills.</p>	<p><b>As of June 21, 2017 Angel Tours no longer reserves mobility seating over the phone.</b> The first row will be reserved for guests with severe mobility needs as determined by the driver. All other seats are available on a first come, first served basis. Remember to sit in the same seat on return home. Guests with restricted mobility will exit the bus last so the driver can assist them off the bus. We ask that single guests sit with other singles when the bus is full. This will avoid conflict and allow couples to sit with each other.
